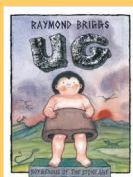


English

Theme

Our focus for **Religious Education** will be Prayer and Worship. The children will explore the religious practices of various faiths.

In **History** we will explore the topic 'Cavemen to Celts' where we look at chronology, timelines and key features of the Stone Age.

Science

We will be continuing our topic on rocks, fossils and soils this term, exploring the characteristics of different rocks and soils. We will also be completing a range of practical investigations and experiments to develop our skills of scientific enquiry.
