We will be using a combination of software packages to create a multimedia presentation.

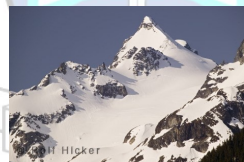
We will attempt using PowerPoint to create quizzes linking to the internet with hyperlinks. Finishing off with animations and sounds to interest the user.
