It's All Greek To Me!



Theme

The children will be looking at Ancient Greek democracy and how it has influenced societies. They will also be looking at and developing their debating skills.

R.E.

At the start of the year we studied the first 2 Pillars of Islam and so this term we will be focusing on fasting, charity and pilgrimage.



Science

This term, Year 6 will be concentrating on investigative skills. They will be devising their own scientific questions to investigate; plan their own enquiry; carry out and evaluate their methods.

This is to prepare them for secondary science in year 7.

Home Learning this term will be in the form of a mini topic on a subject of your child's choice. Plus we will be giving a weekly maths homework.
