Term 1 Curriculum Newsletter



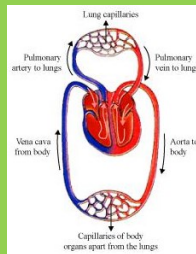
History: We are learning about the events of the war, we will be focussing on the daily life of both civilians and the forces. The children will be developing their skills as investigative historians.

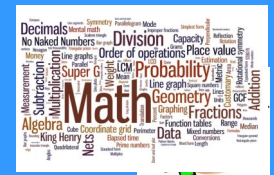
Attendance

We take attendance very seriously at St Paul's. Please ensure your child is in school EVERY day and on time. Thank you.



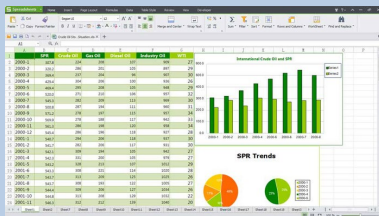
Maths
