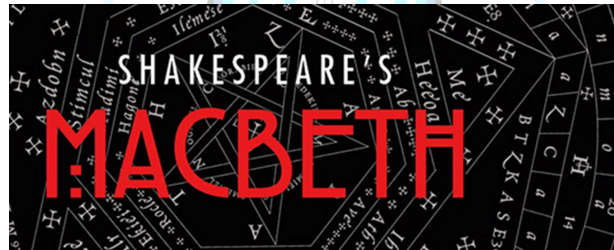


English
