We are continuing with our focus on times tables as many children do not know them off by heart. We would really appreciate it if you had the time to practise them with your children. Children are aiming to be able to answer quick fire multiplication questions rather than counting up to find the correct answer, so regular practice, in school and at home, is key. Children should already be secure in their 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables and we are currently working on learning the 4, 6 and 8 times tables.

As some of you may know, parent consultations are taking place this term on Tuesday 6th March and Thursday 8th March. Letters will be handed out informing you of how to book a time. We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible.

Please continue to provide your child with a PE kit that can be kept in school all week (in case of changes to timetables).

As you know, much of the work we do in class is built on day by day; therefore, it is vital that the children are in school as much as possible and on time for the start of the school day (8.55am).

Also, please ensure your child is dressed in full school uniform every day, including plain black trainers or shoes, and no jewellery. Earrings are allowed as long as they are no bigger in size than a 5p coin. We will be holding random spot checks and awarding house points to those children dressed in correct uniform.
