**Maths-** Fractions and Time

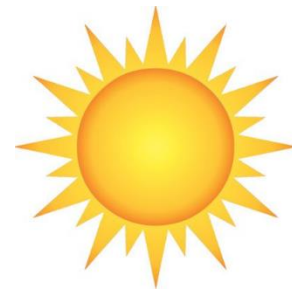
**English-** Leaflet writing and stories
