Numbers Count (Every Child a Counter) Maths Intervention

Intervention Summary:

Numbers count is an intensive 1:1 intervention for children that improves their mathematical skills. The teacher will aim to accelerate your child's learning so that they can work at or above the average level of their class.

Intervention Objectives:

- To help improve a child's mathematical skills
- To develop mathematical vocabulary and to talk about how they do mathematics.
- To build confidence

Note: The teaching is specially designed and delivered by the Numbers Count teacher to meet your child's individual needs.

Length of Intervention:	Up to 12 weeks
Adult leading Intervention:	A trained and experienced ECC teacher
Frequency of intervention:	4 x 30 minutes per week The time slot of each lesson is varied throughout the week to ensure the least disruption to their class work.

How you can help your child:

- Make sure your child is in school every day, so that he/she does not miss any Numbers Count lessons.
- Your child will sometimes bring home a mathematics activity to practise what they have learned. You will be asked to help them to do the activity and to talk about it.
- Watch a Numbers count session at school so you can see what they have learnt and help them to use the strategies at home too
- Be positive about maths!
