<p><b>Spellings</b></p> <p>These have been set as <b>2Dos on Purple Mash</b>.</p> <p>One set on Monday to practice - can practise as often as you like eg/ everyday. Remember to use steps in your instructions and imperative verbs too!</p> <p>◆ Watch the following short film - <a href="#">The Windmill farmer</a>  <b>A conscientious farmer tends to his crop of windmills and watches them blossom through the seasons until sadly the crop is damaged by a winter storm. Helpless the farmer resigns to his fate by the time the thick winter snows arrive.</b></p> <p><b>Y4</b> – write a first person narrative also describing the feelings of the farmer, watching tentatively from the windows waiting for the 'green shoots of 1st growth.' This can be a set of diaries exploring the mood at certain points.</p> <p><b>Y5</b> - There are links with Jack and the Beanstalk, perhaps you can create a story about something else growing from seed. What would you like to grow from seed? A money tree perhaps!</p> <p><b>Y6</b> - Write letters of complaint to the farmer about how his wind farm is spoiling the countryside, or messages of support for his beautiful crop and his efforts to help the environment</p> <p><b>Y4, Y5 &amp; Y6</b> - research wind farms and do a poster of fact file with the information that you find out!</p>
