Reminders

- Please can we ask you to take care when driving/parking around the school. We have, unfortunately had a few incidents of drivers not showing consideration for others.
- Children who have sickness or diarrhoea need to stay at home for 48 hours since last instance of illness.
If your child is ill please telephone the school before 10.00 am on the first day of absence. Please do not leave children unsupervised on the playground before 8.35 am. Doors to all classrooms will remain locked until 8.35 am when a member of staff is available to supervise pupils. This is to ensure the safety of our children. If you require Breakfast Club (even for a short time) please contact Mrs Hamilton.
- Parents are responsible for younger children (on the playground) at the start and end of the school day.
