NUT FREE SCHOOL

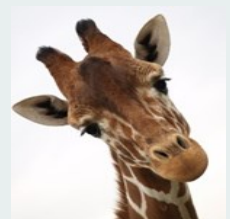
From now on we are completely NUT FREE SCHOOL please due to severe allergies. Please be very mindful of this, lunchboxes will be checked.
