## **PERSONAL KIT LIST**

All items are to be placed in a suitable suitcase or bag with wheels/or that can be carried, and of which your child can manage themselves.

Please ensure that all items of personal clothing are clearly labelled.

Please send them with old clothes only, if possible – things will get muddy & left!

**Please can we ask that you do not attach bags of wellies/sleeping bags to the outside of your child's suitcase, as this makes it difficult for the coach driver to store it within the luggage compartment of the coach.**

### **Absolutely Essential**

Pillow  
Sleeping Bag

### **Necessary**

#### **A Packed lunch for the first day of camp**

At least one change of clothes per day (including some old clothes that can get dirty/wet and disco clothes!)

Some warm clothes (even if the weather is predicted to be nice)

Waterproofs (coats & trousers if possible)

Wellington Boots

**AND** strong walking shoes or trainers (for outdoors)

**AND** a pair of old shoes/trainers that can be worn in the water (Kayaking/rafting)

Night attire

Underwear

Indoor footwear e.g. trainers/slippers

Towels x2

Toiletries (soap, toothbrush, comb etc)

Small rucksack (for wet clothes/lunch)

Hat (for sun or rain, gloves & scarf, depending on time of visit)

A refillable strong drinks container with leak proof top

Sun cream

### **Useful Extras**

Reading book

Money for souvenirs (**MAXIMUM OF £10.00 (£1 coins only – to be placed in a named purse/wallet and headed in to school staff on the morning of the camp).**)

### **Not Needed**

**Computer games, expensive cameras, iPods, mp3 player, mobile phones**

**However a disposable camera would be a great option for a school camp!**
