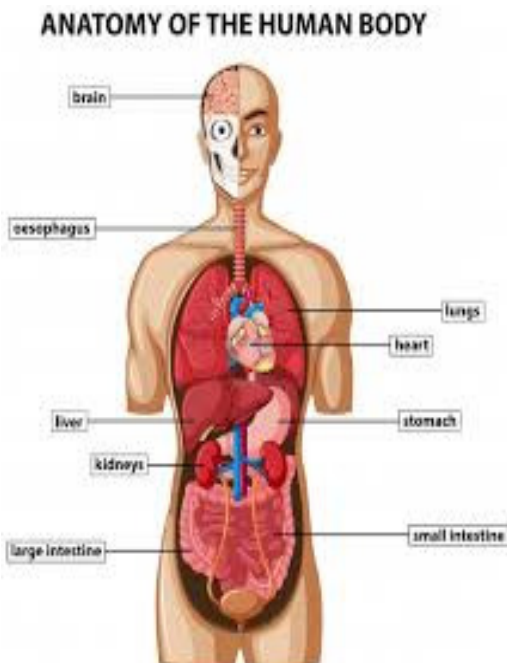
## CLUBS
