We've had a fun week in Class 1!

Reception used numicon to find the total number in two groups and year 1 children have been continuing their unit of work on fractions. In literacy we wrote about our snowy days and we had a amazing time making our own superhero characters from fruit or vegetables. We wrote speech bubbles of what our superhero was going to say and then used an app to record their superhero! In our theme lessons we learnt about different kind of materials ready for our science investigation next week into the best material to use to make a superhero cape.

In numeracy Class 2 have been measuring space including mass, distance and capacity and deciding which equipment and units to use when measuring them. In literacy we have been drafting biographies of someone in our lives. In theme we have been learning about Martin Luther King and Rosa Parks.



We also typed up our invention poems using the laptops.

After the snow day everyone in Class 3 was excited to learn. We learnt to believe in ourselves and get rind of the Chimp in our Minds! We learnt about resilience and perseverance.
