## What we are covering this term:

**English:** Newspaper reports, diary entries, traditional tales, explanation texts, non-chronological reports and poetry.

**Maths:** Place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, length and fractions.

**Science:** Plants, pollination, seed dispersal, rocks and soils, light and forces.

## Creative Curriculum – What Makes A Superhero?

We will be investigating the features of superheroes and reading texts based around the topic. We will search for real-life superheroes and discuss why they are special. The children will be encouraged to think of their own superhero and complete explanations about their creation.

## Creative Curriculum – Who's Creeping Around the Woods?

In the second half of the term, we will investigate Traditional Tales in detail. We will link learning about animals, habitats and diets to our work. The children will also create their own shelters for characters from Traditional Tales.

## Organisation

- Doors open at **8:35am** and close at **8:55am**.
