Severe Weather Procedure

As we start to move into the winter months, we would like to remind you about the school weather procedures.

We will always do our best to keep the school open – but sometimes closure will be the most appropriate step to ensure everyone's safety.

At all times the welfare and safety of students and staff is our key concern. If we need to close the school out of school hours (for example in adverse weather conditions such as heavy snow) we will call & text parents/carers by 7.30am. If we need to close the school during school hours, the school will first contact the parent to inform them of the decision to close and establish if they or someone close is at home to receive the student. The school will then arrange with the taxi company to collect the students from school at their earliest convenience. School will liaise with parents to update them.
