We need to add 'good' to the options on the questionnaire. (1 comment)	We will.
Your child is not reaching their full ability or potential. (1 comment)	Please ask that you make a further appointment to come into school to meet with your child's class teacher and Key Stage Leader so that we can address this more fully.
You're concerned with disruptive behaviour in the class. (1 comment)	Address all instances of any behaviour which do not promote learning but would appreciate the opportunity to discuss your concerns so that we can address them immediately.
You're concerned with the behaviour of parents.(1 comment)	Have worked in close partnership with the community police officers and to our knowledge, this has had a very positive impact on the negative behaviour of a very small minority of parents and carers in relation to disputes around parking and the playground. If this is not the case then please contact Mrs Bullerwell directly to discuss your concerns further.

Feel information about trips etc. should be shared earlier especially if there is a financial cost to families. (1 comment)	Have shared this information with the staff and asked them to inform parents as soon as trips are booked.
You'd like more specific information about your child's academic strengths and areas for development and what learning has been taking place during Parents' and Carers' rather than just how well they are doing. (1 comment)	Have shared this information with staff.
You'd like school to email or post letters to families because you never receive them. (1 comment)	Have considered emails but not every family will provide school with an email address and posting would be very expensive for the school. However, in response to your feedback and because we have mobile contacts for each family, we are going to text parents and carers to alert them to letters when they are sent out to the whole school or to their class.
