



Hello Pupils,

Initial feedback from Pupil Questionnaire 2016

Generally, your responses to the recent pupil questionnaire are pleasing with 90/95 pupils across the whole school saying **overall I am happy with my school**.

Four pupils (Stags) disagreed that they are happy, with one not responding to the question; this places Bow in the second quartile relative to benchmarks.

*It is worth noting though that as a high proportion of pupils 'agreed', rather than 'strongly agreed' that they **enjoy school very much**, Bow is in the bottom quartile for this statement relative to external benchmarks.*

There were also positive outcomes in many of the areas identified for action last year.

There are three areas for action:

- Despite the action taken last year, 21% (14) pupils (mostly Stags) disagree that **homework helps me understand and improve my work**. This is a similar result to last year, and places Bow in the third quartile relative to external benchmarks.
- 9.5% (9) pupils across KS1 and KS2 disagreed that **lunch and play times are well organised**, and 8.5% (8 Stags) pupils disagreed that **grown-ups at lunch time are helpful to me**.
- 13% (12) pupils (mostly Stags) disagreed that **pupils in school behave well**, although external benchmarking suggests we are above average for this statement.

Also for noting, against external benchmarks, across the whole school, we are in the bottom quartile for **encouraged to eat healthily** though only 4 pupils disagreed with the statement, and **know what to do to improve** though only 6 pupils (across years) disagreed with the statement.

As a school we will work together to improve these areas over the next year for you, the pupils, so that your school experience will have a more positive outcome for you.
