## First Aid and Medication

Parents of children requiring medication in school need to ensure that the correct documentation is completed and that all medication comes to school with the prescription labels and packaging.

If a child receives a head bump injury at school and treatment is given, parents will receive a pink slip with the details. All records of accidents and injuries are kept at school and completed by trained staff. If, during the course of a school day, staff have to administer basic first aid (e.g. for a graze), we would not normally inform parents. However, for more serious injuries a member of staff may call you or speak to you at the end of the school day.

Antibiotics can be administered in school if four doses is prescribed by the GP. A three dose per day prescription can be given outside of school hours. If you have any questions regarding first aid, please address these to Mrs Stevens via the school office.
