Our governing body are keen to respond to the Parent Survey that was conducted in the summer term last year. Within the next few newsletters I have been asked to report back on actions that have been addressed since September.

You said...

Risk of the road - concerns about an accident waiting to happen

We have...

Like almost every school in the country parking and drop off is very busy. The staggered entry for children from 08.40 am to 09.00 am (by which time everyone should be in school) when children can be left has improved this. We have met with the local PCSO on two occasions to review the situation. The Parish Council have met at drop off time with Bucks CC transport to look at possible speeding restrictions that could be enforced. The Parish Council have spoken to neighbours about cutting hedges back so there is better visibility for motorists. We have moved the bike racks to the enclosed section at the front of the school as this is much safer than the staff carpark.
