Dear Families

The Year 6 SATs are now well under way and will soon be finished. Our pupils are doing a wonderful job and calmly approached the tests with a great attitude. Mrs France and I are really proud of them all!

In classes we will be learning about the Royal family, weddings and Father Allan is coming to school to lead a mock-wedding with the children.
