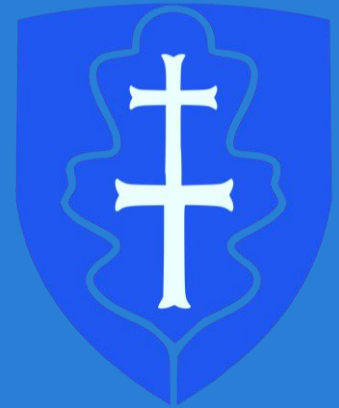

Children across the school will be off timetable as we split into our Houses to rotate around four different activities linking to the theme of 'Harvest of the Sea'. Children need to come to school in sensible multi-non-uniform that parents won't mind if it gets dirty. We will begin and end the day with special acts of worship and there will be no collective worship for families on that day.

This year we would like to support the One Can Trust and I will send out more information about the types of donations we will ask for nearer the time.

## Reminders...

- ✓ Please ensure your child has a **water bottle** with water in it for use in school. Squash is not allowed in water bottles within the school. However, if your child brings their own lunch to school then they may have squash in a lunchbox. If your child has a school lunch and you would like to send a second bottle with squash then you may.
- ✓ **Nail varnish** is not permitted for girls and boys in school. Please ensure nail varnish is removed for school.
- ✓ **Jewellery** - For health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in school. The only exception to this rule is a watch. We discourage children from wearing earrings in school. However, for newly pierced earrings, we recommend that children have plain gold or silver studs. Parents should provide tape to cover these studs for PE lessons. This is to prevent injury.
- ✓ **Toys** – Please remember that children are not permitted to bring toys into school unless asked to by a teacher for part of a lesson. There is large amount of games, sports equipment and toys for all ages of children that can be used at lunch and play times.
