Dear Parents,

We continue to focus on phonics and writing.

This week the sounds are air and ir. Do the speed sound session first, then the spelling session and finally write the sentences below, taking a break between each session.

Monday	air	It is not fair.	The chair is upstairs.
Tuesday	ir	The bird chirps on the branch	I am first not third.

By Wednesday, your child will have completed all of the set 2 sessions but if you feel that they could benefit from working through them again, please continue as they are streamed daily on a rolling program. We have spoken to the Year 1 staff this week and know that the children start Year 1 by recapping the set 2 sounds and using them to write sentences **quickly** and **independently**.



Therefore, working through 'Read Red Words 1' and 'Read and Hold a Sentence 1' sessions each day from Wednesday would be of great benefit to them. Again, they are on a rolling program and are available for 24 hours on the website.
