Pupil Questionnaire – Governor Feedback

The children participated in the pupil survey very well, and were pleased to be asked their opinions. Most of their responses were very positive; we were particularly pleased to hear that

The Head will feedback to each class verbally about the outcomes, and what we will do as a result. It is important that pupils know that action is taken as a result of their comments.

There are a few areas where we would like to take action as a result of the survey:

KS1

16% disagree that they ***know what to do if they find work hard***

12% disagree that they ***know what they need to improve*** (this is also very poor in relation to benchmark)

KS2

20% disagree that their ***lessons are interesting*** (and this is very poor relative to the benchmark)

22% disagree that they ***find it easy to get on with their work in class***

We will:

- **Work together as a staff team to understand this response in a more detailed way, and to share good practice across the school.**

23% disagree that ***homework helps them to understand and improve their work***

We will:

- **Review the new approach to homework, introduced in September 2105, in October 2016, using feedback from pupils, parents and staff;**
- **Provide more information, to pupils and parents, about the purpose of homework, and the way it will support learning and the development of skills.**

11% disagree that they are ***asked for their views about things in school***

16% disagree that they ***feel that they are listened to***

We will:

- **Support children in understanding the many ways in which they are asked for their views, and can talk to staff; especially by using the phrases ‘their views’ and ‘listened to’.**

- Continue to work on supporting pupils to recognise bullying using clear definitions and by making available links to appropriate web-based applications, and by advertising the various ways that pupils can report bullying and bad behaviour.

Whole school

- Hold a Healthy Eating Week (w/b 13 June 2016). Each class will focus on healthy eating for four afternoons in the week, and parents will be invited for an open afternoon.
