Please make sure your child has a PE kit in school at all times.

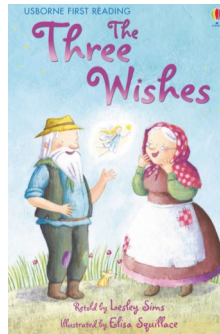
