Snacks: Unfortunately we have noticed several snacks being brought to school that are not in line with school policy. Children in Coddan, Tarka and Barum classes are provided with a fruit or vegetable based snack every day, they **do not** need to bring in additional snacks.

Children in Saunton, Exmoor and Lundy are permitted to bring in a fruit or vegetable snack for play time. This **does not** include snack bars that contain sugar or other processed alternatives or packets such as bread sticks/nuts/cereal bars.

Packed lunches must **not** include confectionary (including chocolates) or sugary drinks. Children have access to water throughout the day, including at lunch time.
