

Sports Premium Funding planned spending for 2017-2018

Salway Ash will continue to effectively use the Sports Grant to raise the profile and outcomes for children in PE, sport and physical activity for all pupils.

For the financial year 2017-2018 the school will have £17,000

Our initial plans for the Sports Premium Funding include:

- Employ a PE and School Sport Apprentice. This was not an option during 16/17 as there were no applicants for the post from the Sporting Futures Training Scheme. A new partnership has been formed with Yeovil College. £4,363
- Sail Shades in order to maximise outdoor use. Not enough grant was available for this in 16/17. This has now been booked with Dorset Countryside Grounds Maintenance for Autumn Term 2017. £6,000
- Continue to support and promote a wide range of existing and new sporting experiences and to provide a range of clubs for pupils at lunchtime and after school with the aim to increase pupil participation, enjoyment and opportunities £3,424.

- Circus Skills
 - Skip2bfit

 - Gymnastics CPD
 - Balancability – bikes, kit bag, helmets, training.
 - 'Head over heels' gymnastics
 - Leadership training for pupils.
