



Governor Class Observations

In order to assess how well the objectives in the School Development Plan are being met, Governors make visits to lessons in order to:

- Appreciate and understand the work of the staff and how the pupils are learning
- Be aware of the response of pupils to their work
- Be aware of resource issues
- Understand as fully as possible the results of progress monitoring

Governors at Salway Ash this term carried out a maths lesson observation of the top class, and were very encouraged to see how well all ability levels were managed, how well the pupils responded to the verbal and written work that they were set during class time and how consistently well behaved the children were in class. School Sports Premium

The Government has allocated funding for PE and sport in primary schools over 3 academic years, starting this year, and has allowed schools to choose how they spend these funds. Salway Ash has used this money in the following ways:
