Footpath & Cycle Path Stoke Orchard to Tredington



Question to Richard Walters -

Are there any schemes or future development plans to build a foot/cycle path from the housing development in Stoke Orchard to Tredington Primary School which will run along the main road?

Reply -

We have no current plans to provide a facility ourselves but we have offered to provide a 50% contribution to the parish in the event that they were able to negotiate locally to provide a route largely through the fields. A route along side the road is unlikely to be possible east of the M5 as there is not enough space without removal of the hedge, which would not be a good thing to do.

To start the process of a foot/cycle path you will need to contact your parish council and let them know you would like one.
