## SCHOOL UNIFORM

We have noticed recently that a number of children are not wearing the correct uniform, particularly children who are wearing trainers to school. Below are the key points from our uniform policy as a reminder of what is acceptable. Children should wear smart black shoes – heels and boots/trainers are **not** permitted.

### Boys:

Dark grey or black trousers  
White polo shirt or shirt  
Green School Jumper  
Black socks and smart black sensible school shoes.

Summer: Grey or black smart shorts.

### Girls:

Black or dark grey dress or skirt  
White polo shirt or shirt  
Green school jumper or cardigan  
Smart black sensible school shoes (no heels)  
White socks or tights in school uniform colours (Grey/Green/Black)

Summer: green checked pinafore dress.

Baseball caps can be worn at playtimes and outside in the summer weather, but we ask that children take them off indoors.

### PE:

Dedworth Green Polo Shirt (available from the school office), black shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Trainers or plimsolls. In winter children should wear a warm jumper (hooded and fleeced tops are allowed), tracksuit bottoms and a t-shirt.

Could I also take this opportunity to remind you that children should have their PE kit in school at all times – please bring it in on a Monday morning and take home on a Friday to wash. Apart from PE lessons, it is useful to have a spare set of clothes for children to change into if necessary.

Thank you for your support in making sure your child does not wear jewellery to school. This is for safety reasons. If your child has pierced ears, a small stud should be worn but the child must be able to remove them for PE.

**Please make sure Uniform is named** and if you do find that you have something belonging to another child, please return it to school so that it can be reunited with its rightful owner. Unfortunately children are not always very good at hanging things on their own pegs or putting clothes away and items do get misplaced – please encourage your child/children to take responsibility for their own belongings.

We appreciate your help and support in making Dedworth Green a smart and purposeful environment for learning.
