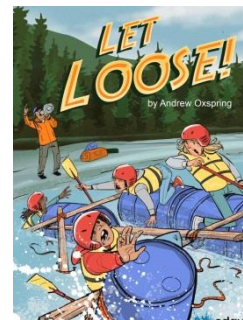
and which side is to the hour.
