Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back and a warm welcome to all children, parents and carers new to our school. Please find, enclosed with this letter, a copy of the Year 3 Curriculum Map for Terms 1 and 2.

At the beginning of the year we will be assessing all the children in order to bridge any gaps that may have arisen, particularly over lock down. We apologise for having to 'quiz' the children so early in the term, but it does really help with our baseline assessments.

Reading books should be brought into school each day. In Year 3, our homework is reading every day to an adult, practising spellings and learning times tables and number bonds. Spellings will be set on a Friday and tested on the following Thursday. We will let you know via Seesaw what your child's spelling list is. (You will be sent a login for Seesaw, along with various other logins, shortly.) We appreciate your support with homework as it is a vital aspect of your child's learning. If you have any concerns regarding the homework your child receives, please contact the school to speak to us.

This year, due to Covid19, children should come in to school wearing their PE kit on the day of their PE lessons. This is Monday and Wednesday for 3CW and Monday and Friday for 3M. Please be aware that windows and doors need to be open as a safety measure and so children need to come to school dressed appropriately for the changeable weather at this time of the year. Please also ensure that all clothing is named and that they have a coat every day. As you know, we are trying to limit the amount of items coming in from home and so all school equipment will be provided and children should not bring in their own pencil cases. Those children bringing in a packed lunch should bring this in a disposable bag, preferably recyclable and with their name on.

We are looking forward to a really exciting term, despite Covid19 restrictions! One of our favourite trips, which can still go ahead, is our Stone Age day at Hill End. The children always love this day and find out so much about our topic. We will be sending more information out about this nearer the time.
