A Note from the Office – Autumn Term 2019.

Please note, all letters (unless a signature is required) will be emailed out to parents via the schoolcomms system not sent out in pupils' bags.

Attendance - Can all parents ensure their child / children arrive at school from 8.50am as this is when the side door will be opened. Nobody is on duty to supervise the children before this time. If you arrive late (after 9:00am) please come to the main door so your child can be signed in.

Absence

Please advise the office by 9:30am if your child is absent from school. If this absence is due to a medical appointment we will need to see a letter or appointment card in order to authorise the absence.

Changes to home time arrangements

Please, wherever possible, notify the office by lunchtime if there are any changes to your child's home-time arrangements. You can do this by telephone or email admin@slaley.northumberland.sch.uk

Uniform / PE Kit

We would like the children to wear a sweatshirt or cardigan, a yellow polo shirt with SFS logo; grey / black trousers/shorts/skirt and safe school shoes. PE Kits are required for all pupils in Reception to Yr 4. Please make sure they have black / blue jogging bottoms as the weather will be getting colder. Uniform can be ordered online from Salto UK Ltd. All items *must* be clearly labelled with your child's name.

Outdoor Education

The children who are with Mrs. O'Neill, Mrs. English & Miss Thompson on a Thursday afternoon, will need to come to school wearing their school uniform sweatshirt and school t-shirt, with black or blue tracksuit bottoms. They will also need to bring wellies and waterproofs with them in a named carrier bag.

Water Bottles

Please can children bring in clearly named, sports-top water bottles to keep hydrated throughout the day.

Dinner Money – The price of school dinners is now £2.40 per meal. However, currently the government are providing Universal Free School Dinners for Reception, Yr1 and Year 2 pupils.

Packed Lunches

As we are a healthy school, we encourage children to bring a healthy packed lunch. This should come into school in a secure named container. Nuts, Sweets or Confectionary are not allowed (We are a 'nut free' school!). Drinks should be water.

Milk Money – From September the price of milk this term will be £8.76 (price to be confirmed). You can pay online via schoolcomms. Under 5s receive free milk. In the term in which a child reaches their 5th Birthday payment will be required.

Medication – If your child needs to take prescribed medication at school, it can only be administered if the school agrees to do so and an official permission form is completed by the parents of the child. This form is available from the school office or school website (Parent Zone).

Changes - Please can all parents advise the office immediately of any changes of circumstances as soon as possible i.e. mobile numbers, address etc.

Schoolcomms– Communication –All Dinner / Milk Money/ Trips etc can be paid on a secure server, which means all communications will be via email / text.
