### A Message from Mrs Hall

#### **Our Value of the Month: Respect**

This value is not just a core British value but also one that has global importance. Respect is thinking and acting in a positive way about yourself and others. It is thinking and acting in a way that shows others you care about their feelings and wellbeing.

**Attendance** Currently the whole school attendance is 94.2%. We are aiming to be as close to 100% as possible...please do not take your children out of school to visit abroad or keep them at home unless they are ill.

We are holding a Passport Challenge this term between Sapphire (91%) and Aquamarine (93%) as these two classes need to improve their attendance. Each child will receive their own Attendance Passport, and on every day that they attend school, the passport will be stamped. Those children who collect a full passport of 20 stamps will have their names entered into a prize draw and 2 children from each class will win a prize. The two classes will also compete against one another to see who achieves the highest attendance during the challenge. A class reward will be awarded to the winning class.
