

This week was STEM week at Frieth. The children have been taking part in some wonderful experiments and investigations all week focussing on Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths. It began with our Star Lab visit last Friday and then followed on throughout the week with activities linked to Space and Forces. Among the many activities included were: sending an egg through a tube system the length of the hall without breaking it; finding out which wafers were the strongest and able to carry loads, linking the science of forces to the engineering of buildings: a colour wheel investigation. These will continue to be

our KS2 science topic in the summer term, so have given the pupils a chance to enrich the science curriculum and get a head start on their learning. It would be remiss not to mention Stephen Hawking and the Eagles class made sure they included a brief section of their class assembly today to the great scientist.



Thank you to Ms Green who organised such a fantastic week of stimulating activities for the school to engage in and learn from.

Also this week, the KS1 classes were visited by Wycombe Fire Brigade and were (literally) squealing




with delight at going outside to look at the fire engine!
