Marlow Community Cop Cards 2017

The Year 6 children have embarked this week on a new initiative which has been set up by the Marlow Policing Team. Fourteen local schools are participating in 'Community Cop Cards' with the aim of encouraging Year 6 pupils to participate in activities within their local community, support charities and have fun.

Although it is the first time of doing this scheme at our school, we are really enjoying it so far. The first briefing about this task was given by our lovely local police department.

What do we need to do?

Until the 20th of June we will each have to collect 24 individual stickers and place them in our special 'Cop Card' booklets. These stickers include: Faith, Personal Safety, Local History, Good Attendance, Respect and Library. In order to get our library sticker we explored the mobile library system on Wednesday this week.



We have also been visited by the NSPCC who talked to us about keeping safe. As Year 6 pupils, we are going to help raise money for this charity by organising a special PE event for the whole school. This will help us to earn our 'Wellbeing' sticker, by not only learning about keeping ourselves safe but also by encouraging us to support others within our school and the wider community.

What other stickers are there?

Three of the main stickers which we need to collect are from members of our local policing team. Not only will they be visiting us in school to help us earn our stickers, but they also have stickers of their own to hand out at the gates. This means that you might see a PCSO, PC or Sergeant outside the school at drop-off or pick up times! In fact, two PCSO's stood outside the gates waiting to

greet Year 6 pupils this morning and were handing out stickers. We had to earn them by answering a series of questions politely. The questions Penny and Ben (PCSO's) asked us were based around the Cop Cards Scheme.



All the Year 6 pupils are really looking forward to getting stuck into this initiative this term and are hoping to win this event!
