**To achieve these, the Home/School Agreement recognises that:**

**The School will:**

- ◆ ensure that the children are taught the curriculum to which they are entitled;
- ◆ contact parents if there are concerns about health or there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- ◆ liaise with parents about concerns regarding their child's performance or behaviour;
- ◆ meet with and report to parents, minimally termly, regarding their child's performance, or as requested by the parent or member of staff
- ◆ encourage children to take care of their surroundings and to be aware of the needs of other people;
- ◆ encourage children to do their best at all times;
- ◆ care for children's safety, welfare and happiness to the best of our ability.

**Parents will:**

- ◆ see that their child attends school regularly, on time and properly equipped;
- ◆ ensure that their child comes to school clean, healthy and ready to learn;
- ◆ ensure PE kit/uniform/ coats/ jackets etc. are clearly named
- ◆ replace any equipment lost or damaged by their child/children
- ◆ inform the school in the event of their child's absence;
- ◆ fully support the school's guidelines for behaviour;
- ◆ let the school have any information which may affect their child's learning or behaviour;
- ◆ support opportunities for home learning, such as homework activities and daily shared reading;
- ◆ attend consultation evenings with teachers to discuss their child's progress;
- ◆ ensure their child wears appropriate school uniform and footwear, has a change of clothes for PE activities and trainers for outdoor PE and Games.

**The Children will:**

- ◆ care for their surroundings and other people;
- ◆ be friendly, polite and helpful at all times;
- ◆ do all their class-work and homework as well as they can;
- ◆ obey the school rules;
- ◆ wear appropriate school uniform and have their PE kit when needed.

**Together we will:**

- ◆ promote the spiritual and moral development of every child within the context of a Christian environment.

## **Frieth School Pupils' Internet Code of Practice**



1. I will only use the internet when supervised by a teacher or adult.
2. I will log off when I have finished using the computer.
3. I know that my teacher can check the sites I have visited.
4. I understand that I can access only sites and materials relevant to my work in school.
5. I understand that I will not be able to use the Internet if I don't use it as expected by my teacher.
6. I know that information on the Internet may not always be reliable.
7. I know that the Headteacher can monitor the contents of my e-mail messages.
8. I will never tell anyone I meet on the Internet where I live.
9. I will never send anyone my picture.
10. I will never arrange to meet anyone in person.
11. I will never respond to unpleasant, suggestive or bullying e-mails or bulletin boards and I will always report it to a teacher or parent.

12. I will not use e-mail to send or encourage material which is inappropriate, illegal, offensive or annoying or invades another person's privacy.
13. I will not look for bad language or unpleasant images while I am online. I will turn off the monitor and tell a teacher or parent if I think something I come across accidentally is inappropriate.
14. I will always be myself and will not pretend to be anyone or anything I am not.
15. I know that the posting of anonymous messages and the forwarding of chain messages is not allowed.
16. I may not download anything from the Internet.
