If you are unsure about something then ASK—We are here to help.

Spelling and grammar STILL matters!

Before posting your question, check if anyone has asked it already and received a reply.

Stay on topic – Don't post irrelevant links, comments, thoughts, or pictures.

Always remember to say "Please" and "Thank you" when asking for help.

Consider what you are saying and writing as once it is said, you can't take it back - like the toothpaste in the tube analogy

Respect the opinions of your classmates. If you feel the need to disagree, do so respectfully and acknowledge the valid points in your classmate's argument. Acknowledge that others are entitled to have their own perspective

Do not to give out personal information as the whole class and parents can see what you type.

THINK before posting anything

Don't write anything that sounds angry or sarcastic, even as a joke, because without hearing your tone of voice, your peers might not realise you're joking.

If you wouldn't do or say something in real life, don't do it online either

Your friends miss you. KEEP IN TOUCH

Comments can be deleted if they are unproductive and/or disruptive and, if this continues, muted
