



FEDERATION NEWS - Another great week. This week I want to say a huge thanks to all the children in Year 6 and their teachers. SATs week is a stressful time and they have all coped incredibly well. I have had the pleasure of teaching the Year 5 children in the mornings this week and would also like to say thank you to them for working so hard.

Vandalism - Sadly, this morning the staff had to clean up a bottle that had been smashed and left on the playground. Obviously, that poses a risk to the children and is difficult for the staff to ensure that they have found all the pieces of glass. Please could you ask your children not to come onto the school site after school, at weekends or during the holiday as we cannot guarantee their safety. From now on, any child seen on the school site will be asked to leave the premises immediately.

Parent language - As the weather gets nicer it is natural for parents to spend a little time chatting when they have dropped off their children or after pick up. I have had a few parents recently who have approached me to say that they are concerned that some parents are congregating just outside the school gates and are using language that is not suitable for school children to be hearing. Please can I ask that all parents are mindful of how they might appear to young children walking to school and also of the language that they are using.

School Gateway – We are beginning to implement an online payments system.
