



FEDERATION NEWS - What a lovely couple of weeks. On Wednesday this week I had the pleasure of joining the Y6 pupils at the residential at Beam House. I saw them bodyboarding, completing a pretty hair-raising trapeze, abseiling and fencing in just the few hours that I was there. It was lovely to see the children enjoying a great range of activities, behaving well and learning to develop a range of skills that they would not necessarily get from the classroom.

Ofsted – As you know, we had a visit from two Ofsted inspectors last week at St Peter's. Unfortunately, I am not allowed to share details of the visit until the report is released, which will be in approximately 25 working days. I would like to say thank you to all the children and staff for all their hard work during the two days and for the hard work and dedication that they show day in and day out. I would also like to say a huge thank you to all of the parents who were able to speak with the inspectors in person or completed the online questionnaire. The Lead Inspector, Sue Costello, asked that I write in the newsletter how grateful the team were for the enthusiasm of the parents which made evidence gathering easier and showed the strength of our relationship.

One strand for improvement that came out of the parent response was that we need to improve our systems for sharing with you the academic progress of your children. This is something that the staff, governors and I will think about over the remainder of this term. When we have come up with a few potential solutions I will be really keen to receive your ideas on them, so that we can ensure that we are fully meeting your needs in this area.

Staffing and Classes – Over the next week or two we will be organising the children into their classes for next year. This will be shared with you as soon as we are able to do so.

After over twenty years in teaching, much of it at St Peter's, Mrs Lewis has decided to leave us, in order to retrain so that she can take up a new role in the future. It is quite likely that we will still see her around as a supply teacher at times. We are currently advertising for an experienced Y5/6 teacher to replace Mrs Lewis for September.

Ties – It's got to that time where children are free to take off their ties. Please could this be **from Monday 25th June and not before**. Please could I also ask that you keep them easy to locate at home as there will be some school events where the children are asked to wear them.

Sports Day – This will be held at St Peter's CE Junior School on Friday 22nd June – (St Peter's children will have theirs in the morning – 9.30am start; and St Rumon's children will come up in the afternoon for 12.30 start.) It will be lovely to see as many parents there as can make it. Unfortunately, the British weather is not always predictable and so, please could you ensure that children have hats, sunscreen and plenty to drink on that day. Additionally, if it is slightly damp then a waterproof coat would be useful. We will send a text if we need to cancel. The decision to cancel a sports day will be made on the quality of ground underfoot.

The PTA will be serving refreshments at the Sports Day, so please let us know or leave your names at either school office, if you are able to help out for an hour or two between 9am and 3pm.

Art Exhibition – Artwork produced by our Year 5 pupils will join other primary school children's work at an exhibition in Butchers Hall – last day is this Saturday, 16 June. Please do go along and take a look and support our children who have created some fantastic pieces.

PTA Summer Fair - The Summer Fair is taking place on Friday the 22nd of June, from 15h30 - 18h00, at St Peter's, after Sports Day. Everyone is welcome! We will once again have a Chocolate Tombola at the Fair, so will be having a **Mufti Day on Friday, 15th of June (tomorrow)**, where pupils may wear normal clothes to school in return for a chocolate donation for the Tombola. We also need wine bottles (both full and empty bottles) for the Water or Wine Game, so please could donations be left at either school office. If anyone has a gazebo that we could borrow for the day,

please could these be brought to either office, as soon as possible, so we have them ready for both events. Many thanks in advance!

We need to borrow gazebos to keep the sun (or rain) off the children at Sports Day and the stalls at the Summer Fair, so please let us know if you have one we could use, or leave it at either school office if you have one.

As the Summer Fair is at St Peter's, we are requesting St Peter's pupils to bring in eats for the refreshments stall - please bring in cakes, biscuits, cupcakes, scones, or other eats suitable for the Refreshments Stall to school on Friday the 22nd of June. (We will ask St Rumon's pupils to do the same for the Christmas Fair at St Rumon's in December).
