Dear Parents and Carers

Despite the rain, our building work remains on schedule and the sub structure is nearly complete. Class 2's classroom will be the first to be extended and whilst the works are going on they will be relocated to the hall. Their big move will be on Friday 17th November, and all the children's bags and coats will be stored in the hall. From Monday 20th November Class 2 will be collected from the front entrance. If they have a sibling in Class 1 then they will leave from the staff room/library entrance.

As promised, here are some ideas to ease the parking and traffic situation:

1) The Chapel roof repairs are due to be completed at the end of the month and then the **Chapel Car Park** will be back in use. Jess Lancaster and Laura Dyer (thank you!) are looking into the possibility of organising a walking bus from there – please see them for more details.

2) I also feel it would be worth trying a **voluntary one-way system** along the road in front of the school. It obviously can't be enforced but it might make a difference.

3) Finally, I will open the **staff car-park** gates at the end of the day so if you see a space that has been vacated please use it. We are also double parking and trying to squeeze as many cars in the staff car park as possible. Hope this helps.

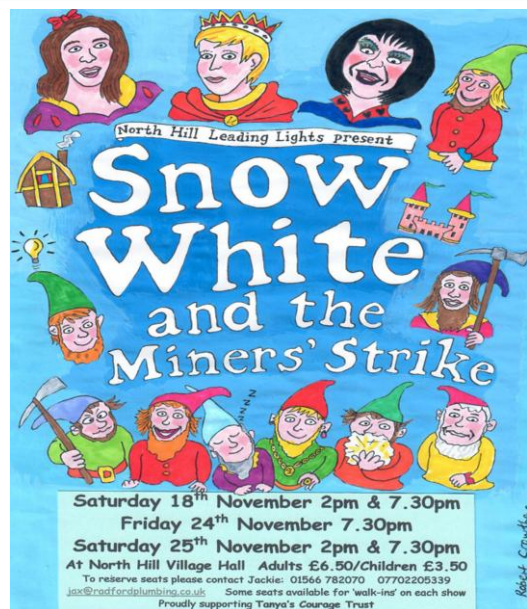
