

Summer 1

This half term we will be studying the topic of Ancient Egypt, learning about when it was and how the people lived.

We will also be learning about light and shadow, which will include making dark boxes and sundials. We will find out about reflective materials, mirrors and symmetry and create shadow puppet theatres and plays.

Literacy

- Recount, fact files & interviews

Numeracy

- Fractions - including understanding tenths, adding and subtracting fractions and equivalent fractions.
- Geometry - including turns and angles and 2 and 3-D shape.
- Measurement - Telling the time, understanding months and years and hours in a day.

Science - Identifying light sources and learning about the Sun. Establishing that light is reflected off things that we see, and that darkness is an absence of light. We will make sundials and look at the transparency of various materials and the shadows they form, including making enquiries about shadows.

Computing - Designing a course for a programmable robot, film and animation.

History - Ancient Egypt. Placing it on a timeline and finding out how the Ancient Egyptians lived.

DT - Designing and making shadow puppets and theatres. Mechanisms.

PE - Swimming, cricket, tennis, football.

RE - Christianity - Identify texts that come from a Gospel, which tell the story of the life and teaching of Jesus.

Music - Charanga - learning a variety of songs for performance.

French - Days and months, saying the date and when your birthday is.

PSHE - Jigsaw - Relationships.
British Values - Democracy

This half term's work will focus on storytelling and the study of Wadebridge and where it is in the World.
