

English skills and development.

As creative writers, we will be looking at traditional tales and exploring the patterns made. We will be using 'The three little pigs' to adapt and create our own endings. We will also be studying non-fiction writing to create our own fact files. Following on from this we will be exploring a range of environmental poems to write and perform our own. We will continue to learn year 2 spelling patterns alongside exception words.

Mathematical skills and development.

As mathematicians, we will continue to develop our understanding of addition and subtraction using these skills in practical and problem solving contexts. We will be learning to measure accurately using a variety of scales and continuing to tell the time. This term we will begin to deepen our understanding of multiplication and division by using arrays, bar models and grouping to help solve problems.
