

Mathematical skills and development

Year 3

As mathematicians, we will be solving number problems and practical problems involving place value. Recognise and count in fractions. Continue to develop our understanding of mental addition and subtraction. Be confident in known multiplication facts for year 3. Tell the time to 5 minute intervals.

Year 4

As mathematicians, we will be recognising negative numbers in relation to number lines and temperature. Use times tables to solve fraction problems. Develop our understanding of column addition. Begin to be confident in all 12 multiplication facts. Tell the time digitally and for AM/PM.

Music

As musicians, we will be learning about the famous European composers Beethoven, Mozart and Tchaikovsky. We will also be creating our own music, which will tell a story and creates mood and feelings.

English skills and development

As creative writer's, we will be reading the book 'A Walk Around London' by author Salvatore Rubbino. We will adapt this fiction and non fiction book for our own tourism booklet about the beautiful city Paris.

We will also be looking at the book Leon and The Place Between by Angela McAllister.

Science

As scientists, we will be developing our understanding of Living Things and their habitats, including learning about invertebrates and go on a bug hunt in our School Garden.

Later in the term, we will be learning about Animals including Humans, focusing on our own health and well being.
