Thank you to all the parents who came along to the meeting this week with Mrs Skinner. We hope that we were able to give you a better understanding as to how the programme works and really helps children to develop their reading skills and understanding of texts that they have read. If there are any aspects of accelerated reader that you would like explained further Mrs Skinner is more than happy to answer the questions you may have. Teachers have already seen a big difference in how well the children are reading and how motivated they are with their reading. We are hoping that the whole school can reach their next target of 1.2 million words in a week.

Maths Open mornings

We will once again be holding two open mornings for parents to come and see how we teach the four rules to our children in classes 2, 3 and 4.
