Christmas Cards

Josephine Hughes (year 2) and her Mummy Camilla are selling Christmas cards for Prader-Willi syndrome Association (PWSA). It is a charity close to their hearts as Camilla's good friend Becky has a little boy that was born with this incurable genetic syndrome.

Some features of PWS are weak muscle tone, obesity caused by excessive appetite and overeating, learning disability, short stature, excessive sleepiness, and poor emotional and social development.

Dealing with PWS is now a lifelong challenge for this lovely family. Josephine and Camilla will be selling Christmas cards in the hope that the money raised can improve research and finding a cure might be possible for the future. So, if you're buying Christmas cards this year, please consider buying them for PWSA so that this worthwhile charity can benefit just a little.

This is little Arlo. When he was born he didn't cry, was floppy and had an inability to feed. Arlo has physiotherapy regularly and daily growth hormone injections to help him grow and to help his muscle mass. He also has regular input from speech and language, Arlo's parents and 5 year old sister are currently learning to sign so that Arlo can communicate. A big part of PWS is the constant hunger so at the age of 2 he is already on a very strict diet. He won't be allowed chocolate or crisps or any treats and no white carbohydrates. Despite the constant hunger, Arlo is also only allowed 2/3 of the calories of an equivalent child.

Amazing Arlo has just turned 2 and his first 2 years have been a huge challenge...it would be so good if we could try to make the rest of his (and anyone else who suffers in this way) life a little easier.
