

## Trelissick Camp - A quick reminder

- We leave St. Mewan at 9.30am Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July on Roselyn Coaches/school minibus. Providing the weather is fine, we will all collect on the playground with luggage (to avoid unnecessary carrying of bags to and from the classroom). If the weather is inclement, pupils can come straight to the classroom with their bags, from 8.45am.  
  
\*Travel Sickness tablets for those needing them on coaches or boats will need to be provided, labelled with name and dosage (enough for two bus journey and two boat journeys).
- YOU DO NOT need to provide any food for your child during this camp BUT will need to provide an empty lunch box and large, refillable drinks bottle.  
\* Any sweets etc. provided will be confiscated as this will attract rodents and other biting animals!
- Any child taking medication will need to complete a form authorising staff to administer this and ALL medicines will need to be held by staff. These must be given to Mr Gibson & Mrs Bolitho on the morning of the trip (or prior to) and must be clearly labelled with Name, dosage and when to administer.
- Luggage: Please send your child with just ONE named bag containing everything on the kit list as well as one strong named plastic bag (don't use a bin bag) containing a Sleeping bag; pillow and sleeping mat. Pupils will also need a small day rucksack for daily use, including waterproofs, sun-lotion, sun hats, an empty lunchbox and a FULL drinks bottle. Empty plastic bags for dirty clothes, also appreciated!
- As we will not be visiting any shops, please do not send any money with your child as they will not need it.
- Mr Towe or Mrs Walker will be the emergency contacts during school hours: 01726 – 74887. Should you have any urgent need to contact your child in the event of an emergency, please ring the school on this number, and they will contact us. Out of school hours, the contact number, for emergency use only is 07444430497
- Please do not send your child with a mobile phone/electronic devices or any contact device, as this will be confiscated due to fire risk if they were to get wet in the tents.
- Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July at approximately 7pm the children will arrive back at school with their luggage. Should there be any delay, the school will be contacted and these details will be sent out via twitter and the website.
