### **Attendance and unauthorised Absence**

I have recently met with our Education Welfare Officer, whose role is to monitor and support improving school attendance. This year the school's target for attendance has been 97% and to date we have reached 96.3%, which is good, but it would be even better if we could reach the target next year.

Please be aware that if your child is absent of a total of 10 unauthorised sessions (that is 5 school days) in a year that the local authority is highly likely to impose a penalty fine. Should your child have a further 10 unauthorised sessions the following year this is likely to result in legal proceedings and a court hearing, where a much larger fine could be imposed.
