COVID Testing for Families

On Sunday 28th February, the Department of Health and Social Care announced that from Monday 1st March, households with primary school, secondary school and college age children, including childcare and support bubbles, can test themselves twice every week at home as schools return from Monday 8th March. The twice-weekly test kits can be accessed by:

- collecting a home test kit from a test site
- ordering a home test kit online

The **collection for these tests is Maer Road carpark in Exmouth**. You can collect tests between 1.00pm and 7.00pm and you do not need to have an appointment.
