Parking

We have been notified by a number of residents that some parents are not being as considerate as they could be with their parking when dropping off or collecting their children, especially along Town Lane and in Orchard Close. Please can you ensure that you are not blocking anyone's drive and that if parking in Town Lane that there is enough space for lorries and emergency services to pass. Please make use of the village hall carpark in Flower Street, as this is just a few minutes' walk to the school.

Head lice

Recently, cases of head lice have been identified across the school and we wanted to make sure you were kept informed. Whilst lice are nothing more than a nuisance, it is important that children are checked on a weekly basis so that any head lice can be dealt with quickly and before they are allowed to spread.

Here is some simple advice you may wish to follow to keep head lice outbreaks to a minimum.

- Check your child's hair once a week
- Use a proper detection comb – with teeth no more than 0.3mm apart to trap head lice.
- If you find live lice, consult a pharmacist for treatment advice.
